

SES International B.V. and your personal data

SES International B.V., hereinafter also referred to as SES, supplies products and services to companies and institutions. We have reviewed the General Data Protection Regulation (AVG) and came to the conclusion that we are processing some personal data. SES attaches great importance to the protection of these personal data. In this privacy policy we want to provide clear and transparent information about how we handle personal data. We do everything to ensure your privacy and therefore handle personal data with care.

In all cases, SES adheres to the applicable laws and regulations, including the GDPR. This implies that -at least- we:

- process your personal data in accordance with the purpose for which it was provided, these purposes and type of personal data are described in this privacy policy.
- guarantee that processing of your personal data is limited to only those data that are at least necessary for the purposes for which they are processed.
- ask for your explicit consent if we need it for the processing of your personal data.
- have taken appropriate technical and / or organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data.
- do not transfer personal data to other parties, unless this is necessary for the purposes for which they were provided.
- are aware of your rights regarding your personal data and we want to emphasize that we respect it.

Your personal data is processed by SES for the following purposes:

For the above objectives, we may request the following personal data from you:

Distribution to third parties

We may provide the information you've provided to us to third parties if this is necessary for the purposes described above.

For example, we use a third party for financial accounting.

We never transfer personal data to other parties with whom we have not concluded a processing agreement. In all cases the necessary arrangements with these parties (processors) guarantee the security of your personal data.

Furthermore, we will not provide the information you provide to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted. As an example: a police request (personal) regarding data in the context of an investigation. In such a case we must cooperate and are therefore obliged to provide this information. We can also share personal data with third parties if you give us written permission for this. We do not provide personal data to parties based outside the EU.

Minors

We do not process any personal data of minors (persons under the age of 18).

Retention period

SES does not store personal data for longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or is required by law.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing.

Rights regarding your data

You have the right to check, rectify or delete your personal data that we collected. You can object to the processing of your personal data (or part of it) by us or by one of our processors. You also have the right to have your data transferred to yourself or directly to another party if desired. For security and privacy

purposes we can ask you to provide us proof of your identify before we can respond to the aforementioned requests.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, we ask you to contact us about this. If we can't settle the issue, we are very sorry. You have the right to submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens), which is the privacy supervisory authority. If you have
